our last two summer events.

First English-Polish camp "Find your APP" was successfully held for 110 children 6-13 years old June 22-29 in the recreation "Happiness" in the village Ozero. We had kids who didn't have father or mother or both parents and kids from poor families... We also had 2 kids whose fathers died at war... The children had a wonderful opportunity to interact with native English speakers from the USA and UK as well as native Polish speakers from Poland. While being at camp, campers had the opportunity to try themselves in different spheres of life, such as family, education, science and technology, culture



and art, media, economy and church. The children could start to think where they see themselves in the future. The camp program included English, Polish, craft lessons, a variety of exciting games, flashmob preparation and also lessons of Christian ethics at the end of the day. Participants had the opportunity to show their talents in singing, dancing, playing musical instruments, showing fashion, making short films in a warm friendly evening atmosphere and having talk time around the campfire at last night while saying good bye to each other.







Second English day camp "Find your APP" was successfully held with children aged 6-13, August 10-21 (2 weeks) at "New Life" Church in Lutsk. 85-100 children were busing camp every day. Children from poor families were attending our camp too. Campers had the opportunity to try themselves in different professional roles such as artist, researcher, journalist, sportsman,



musician and actor. During the first camp we were building relationship bridges with children and during the second one, we were studying with them the book of Jonah through inductive Bible study method. We had surprise profession every day where participants became cooks, designers, astronomers, potters, architects and poets. The children had creative English lessons, developed city projects, performed interesting science experiments, wonderful reports, sang famous

songs and wrote their own, played sport games and participated in dramas.



Both camps were organized and held by the volunteers of "Territory 2.2" NGO, and teachers of "Be Smart" Language Center in Ukraine.
